Hike the Inca Trail en route to Machu Picchu. Spend time in a lodge learning about the biodiversity of the Amazon. Or just surf off the coast of Lima and get back in time for dinner.

Life in Lima



The best time to visit Lima during any Peru vacation is between December and April when the coastal fog breaks and the sun shines bright on the city's gorgeous beaches. With diverse restaurants and shopping, Lima is a cosmopolitan city with a diverse population. Be sure to visit the Plaza de Armas, where you can watch the changing of the guard at the Government Palace. Any history buff must visit the Museum of Anthropology and Archaeology to marvel at the collection of pottery and textiles. Spend time in the San Isidro and Miraflores neighborhoods to shop, eat and enjoy theatre.

If adventure equals romance, then you will delight in travel to Peru. Machu Picchu's magic and energy should work wonders. Then take the train to the Sol y Luna Lodge in the Sacred Valley of the Inca.
