





RCHAEOLO-GISTS using computers to reconstruct the crumbling Sphinx discovered the ancient wonder is a dead ringer for President Bush!

"It's an astounding coincidence," says Mohammed El Salim, part of the international restoration team. "The American leader should be greatly honored."

The Great Sphinx of Giza is also called Guardian of the Horizon. It faces the rising sun and was constructed 4,500 years ago to honor an Egyptian king.
