LEMONT TERMINAL Lemont, IL • 502-415-3731

Located 25 miles southwest of downtown Chicago, this terminal provides bulk, non-bulk, and break-bulk warehousing and stevedoring services. This facility features a climate controlled, 48,000 square foot warehouse with potential for expansion. Convenient truck access to Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, and Wisconsin, and U.S. Inland Waterway access to Mexico, Texas, Louisiana, Alabama, Florida, Pennsylvania and points in between, make this terminal a powerful multi-modal resource.



ST. LOUIS TERMINAL

St. Louis, MO • 800-638-2134

This facility is designed specifically for the transloading of coal from railcars onto barge for multi-modal delivery to coal utility plants. Served by the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway, it is a key facility for the transfer of Powder River Basin coal to large volume users in the Midwest, Southeast and export market. The terminal is on the Mississippi River and features a rotary dump house, belt scales, blending services and on-site storage.



MEMPHIS TERMINAL

ACL's liquid terminal, located within minutes of downtown Memphis, Tennessee, is strategically located with access to Interstates 55 and 40, and the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway. This facility specializes in liquid tank storage for third parties with 100,000 BBLS of storage tank capacity. It caters to diverse liquid cargoes including chemical, petroleum, renewable fuels and vegetable oils, and offers services such as oil recycling, storage, waste water disposal, steaming and more.
