Like A Man Is Hailed As Cohen's "Greatest Accomplishment To Date"

Charismatic singer-songwriter **Adam Cohen** has confirmed a summer tour of the United States, opening for **Rufus Wainwright**. Cohen, whose *Like A Man* (April 3, Decca) has been called his "greatest accomplishment to date" (*BlackBook*) and a "gem of a record" (*Dallas Morning News*). Cohen recently played to packed houses across Europe, Australia, New Zealand, and Asia.

The tour will begin on July 25, 2012 at Penn's Landing River Stage, 1212 Columbus Blvd., Philadelphia. Doors open at 6:00 pm. Cohen's set is at 6:45 pm. Tickets are \$39.50 and can be purchased via Ticketmaster.com.

Writing in *AllMusic*, Thom Jurek observes that *Like A Man* marks "the first time [Cohen's] own voice so completely possesses his material," and declares, "Measure him up to other great songwriters of his own generation – born between the late '60s and the mid-70s – and he shines."

NPR's 'All Things Considered' recently profiled Cohen, and host Audie Cornish praised the album's "masculine romanticism," while New Hampshire Public Radio's Virginia Prescott noted that listening to *Like A Man* is like "being let in on a secret."

Cohen will showcase material from his "strikingly personal album" of ten intimate songs that "truly fit to bear the family name" (*Sunday Times of London*). Joining Cohen will be his longtime musical cohorts, multi-instrumentalist/singers **Mai Bloomfield** and **Michael Chavez**.

Betty Wright and The Roots Unveil Betty Wright: The Movie On November 15 (S-Curve Records/Ms. B Records)

Guests Include Lil Wayne, Snoop Dogg and Joss Stone

Soul music icon **Betty Wright** – singer, composer, producer, arranger, vocal coach and spiritual godmother to countless young artists – has announced the release of **Betty Wright: The Movie** (S-Curve Records/Ms. B Records) on November 15. This is her first solo album since 2001's *Fit For a King*, but don't call this a comeback: Ms. B has never gone away.

Indeed, the 15-time Grammy nominee and Grammy winner for Best R&B song "Where Is The Love" has never been busier: Wright co-produced **Joss Stone's** first two albums, **The Soul Sessions** and **Mind, Body & Soul**, the latter of which won a Grammy nomination for Best Pop Album in 2005. In 2006, Wright was hand-picked by **Sean "Diddy" Combs** to be the vocal coach for the hit TV show **Making the Band**.

2008 was a particularly prolific year for Wright: she co-produced two songs on **Tom Jones' 24 Hours**, was nominated for a Grammy with **Angie Stone** for the single "Baby," and was a Grammy nominee for Album of the Year as a writer, producer and singer on **Lil Wayne**'s triple platinum selling **Tha Carter III**, which includes Wright's duet with Lil Wayne, "Playing With Fire." Just last year, Wright's single "Go!" received a Grammy nod for Best Traditional R&B Vocal Performance.

Betty Wright: The Movie serves up 14 earthy, funk-drenched soul anthems, all of which were cowritten by Wright and co-produced by Wright, **Ahmir "Questlove" Thompson** of **The Roots**, and **Angelo Morris**.

Wright, affectionately known to friends and family as Ms. B, reflects on the album's title: "I am more griot than singer. You can usually see what I say." She continues "I decided that each song would be a vision that you could take to the screen...14 songs equal 14 movies."

She has been releasing music on her own Ms. B label for 25 years. This album is Ms. B Records' first in collaboration with S-Curve Records, which is helmed by producer/executive **Steve Greenberg**. Wright wryly observes "I try not to release any music until I have something to say. Since I *have* something to say, I turned to my trusted friend Steve Greenberg. We've been successful in joint ventures many, many times." Greenberg responds "I believe Ms. B Records combined with S-Curve Records is a marriage made in heaven – or at least in soul heaven, definitely!"

The album kicks off with "Old Songs," a sentimental paean to classic soul that name checks some of Ms. B's favorites, both old and new. A vibrant and varied group of guests accompanies Wright, including members of hip-hop neo soul trailblazers The Roots.

Tower of Power's Lenny Williams duets with Wright on the plaintive ballad "Baby Come Back."

The formidable duo of **Lil Wayne** and **Snoop Dogg** appear on the album, as well as Wright's protégée **Joss Stone**. The soul prodigy joins her in a poignant call and response on "Whisper in the Wind."

The album closes with the powerful Grammy-nominated single "Go," a ten-minute-plus epic that sheds light on the issue of domestic violence. Wright notes "I made this record for those victims of abuse whose name *won't* make the headlines, but whose pain is just as real."

Wright began singing at about the time she began walking: she started performing with Miami-based gospel **The Echoes** at age three and remained with them for the next seven years. She released her first single at age 13 and had her first bona-fide smash at 19: "Clean Up Woman," earning her a gold record and the first of her fifteen eventual Grammy nominations.

From "Clean Up Woman" though the Grammy-winning "Where Is the Love," Wright has scored eleven Top 30 R&B hits and made music business history by becoming the first female artist to earn a gold record on her own label with 1988's **Mother Wit**. In recent years, she has become a highly sought-after producer, writer, arranger, and vocal coach. Her legacy lives on as she continues to be among the most in-demand vocalists around.

Simply put, *Betty Wright: The Movie* reasserts her as one of the greatest soul singers of all time.
